Why a discussion about future activities?

- CDPH agreement with funders:
 "CDPH will consult with the SAG to identify future risk communication and exposure reduction activities that could be implemented with additional funding ..."
- March 8th SAG meeting exercise with the objective of capturing ideas for future activities that could be done under the SFBFP- SAG members reviewed a list of activities that had already been suggested during past SAG meetings along with some additional activities suggested by CDPH. The SAG members suggested more activities.
- Online survey was created in April to summarize these activities and to get more input on their importance.

I. FutureActivities:Summaryof Themes



Continue Current Activities (SAG, small grant program, educational materials, training/technical assistance)

- Asses progress/accomplishments and use this information to guide how to move forward
- Promote work
- Finding/leveraging more resources

Small grant program — Target populations

- fishermen, fish consumers, subsistence fishermen,
- subsistence fishing communities, women, women of childbearing age, children, students

Enhance Evaluation Activities Continue to evaluate — what is most effective?

- Explore evaluation resources
- More CDPH support with evaluation of funded groups' projects

Research Projects

- Research to document and characterize subsistence anglers
- How many people eat more than advisory levels?
- Are SF Bay fish sold in local stores?
- Survey to determine if fish frequently consumed have not been sampled

Educational Materials and activities

- Develop specific educational materials such as a comic book for children or tip card for anglers
- Develop social media (You tube videos, Facebook pages, Twitter, etc.), and video and audio messages
- Integrate fish contamination information into mercury reduction programs
- Develop SFB fish educational curriculum
- Integrate fish messages into health care programs, schools, peer outreach, workshops, community events...

II. Next Steps

- Development of SFB sign was a possible future activity but we were able to do under current project
- Continue to convene the SAG possible fall meeting topics:
 - Synthesis of findings from funded groups
 - Report back on signage posting and media event
 - Collaborate with Delta activities
